## The Little Way of St. Thérèse: To be a Saint in the Twenty- first Century October 20, 2018

But Thérèse, a Doctor of the Church, assures us that she was not perfect and that her Little Way of holiness is possible for us because God Himself will raise us to sanctity. Our spiritual calling is to be honestly aware of our imperfections, and in our repentance and fidelity, to welcome God's mercy. Then, in the ordinary activities of life to share God's mercy by not retaliating and by loving ourselves, others and God.
